The family-owned and managed Carrbridge Hotel is situated inside the Cairngorm National Park. Set in breathtaking scenery on the banks of the River Dulnain. All rooms are ensuite with TV, telephone and tea/coffee making facilities. Lift

- Day 1 Morning departure. Stops en route. Check in to our hotel enjoying dinner bed and breakfast throughout the stay.
- Day 2 Kyle Railway Line and Skye Cruise. After breakfast head to the 'Capital of the Highlands' - Inverness. Where half the passengers will board the train to Kyle of Lochalsh, known as one of the most outstanding journeys in the world. (The other half taking the journey by coach). Once you arrive in Kyle of Lochalsh all passengers will climb aboard the glass bottom boat of Seaprobe Atlantis for a cruise heading out underneath Skye bridge and out to seal Island. You will have a chance to see the local wildlife above and below the water. Return to Kyle where the other half of the passengers will take the return journey to Inverness. The journey by road is different to the rail journey. Return to the hotel in time for dinner and entertainment.
- Day 3 Loch Ness and Urquhart Castle. Today you have the morning free to explore Inverness before taking the short journey to Loch Ness Clansman Harbour. Here you will board the cruiser to take you out on the Loch and to Urquhart Castle. With entrance to the visitor centre included, return by boat to the harbour where you will board the coach and return to the hotel for dinner and entertainment.
- Day 4 Aviemore and Funicular Railway. Your last full day of touring will take you to the magnificent Cairngorm Mountains. Firstly you will have time in Aviemore before boarding the UK's highest Mountain Railway.
- Return to your coach, stop and visit Speyside Heather Garden and visitor centre before returning back to our hotel for dinner and entertainment.
- Day 5 After a hearty breakfast it's time to return home to North Wales.
